

Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy is effective as of November 14, 2016.

Sli.do s.r.o. provides the Privacy Policy to inform users about policies and processes regarding the collection, use and disclosure of personally identifiable information received from users of sli.do on www.sli.do and other domains runned by sli.do s.r.o. ("Sites").

What information do we collect?

We collect and process information from you when you create an event, interact with an event or register on our sites. You may be asked to enter details about you and your feedback in order to provide you better experience.

Why do we need your information and how we use it?

We collect information from you in order to enhance your user experience, namely following:

- Personalize your experience and make using our sites easier and faster for you.
- Provide you better insights.
- Improve our website and services based on your feedback.
- Provide you with support.

In case you decide to try our new features, tagged as "BETA" ("Beta Product"), you consent to help us to further develop and improve them.

By using our services in Beta Version you consent that we may process your data (including but not limited to the personal data) with help of 3rd parties on your behalf; however we may use such consent solely in order to deliver mentioned services to you.

How do we keep your information protected?

We store your data on our servers located within the European Union and United States. We implement a large palette of security measures in order to maintain the safety of your personal data when we collect and process them. When it comes to security we strictly follow our Security Standards.

How do we use cookies?

We use cookies on our sites for two main reasons:

1. In order to save your settings for future visits.
2. To store your interaction with our sites

We use the information collected using cookies to improve our sites and services. We may also contract with third party service providers in order to help us improve our business and services.

Do we disclose information to third parties?

We do not sell, trade or otherwise transfer your personal information to third parties. We may provide the information about your activity to trusted third parties, as long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. This information is used mainly for improving our services and for research purposes.

We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect ours or others rights, property, or safety. Non-personally identifiable information may be provided to other parties for marketing, advertising, or other uses.

As these have separate and independent privacy policies, we have no responsibility and liability for the content and activities of these linked sites. However, we do our best to protect the integrity of our site and welcome any feedback about these sites and services.

As we are in the compliance with the requirements of COPPA (Childrens Online Privacy Protection Act), we do not collect any information from anyone under 13 years of age. Our sites are directed to people who are at least 13 years old or older.
